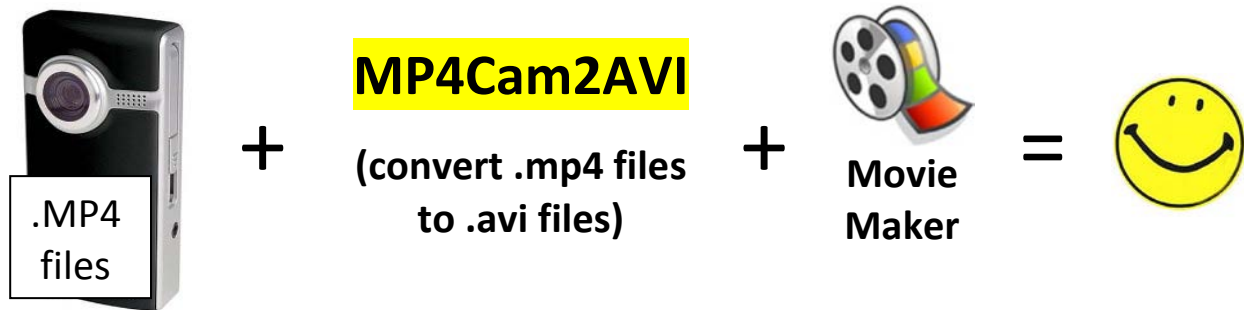


MP4Cam2AVI

The problem Movie Maker has with .MP4 files has been solved.

As the name implies, the program converts .MP4 files into .AVI files, which can then be used with the District Standard video editor, Movie Maker.

This means the newer “Flip Ultra” cameras can now be easily used with Movie Maker.



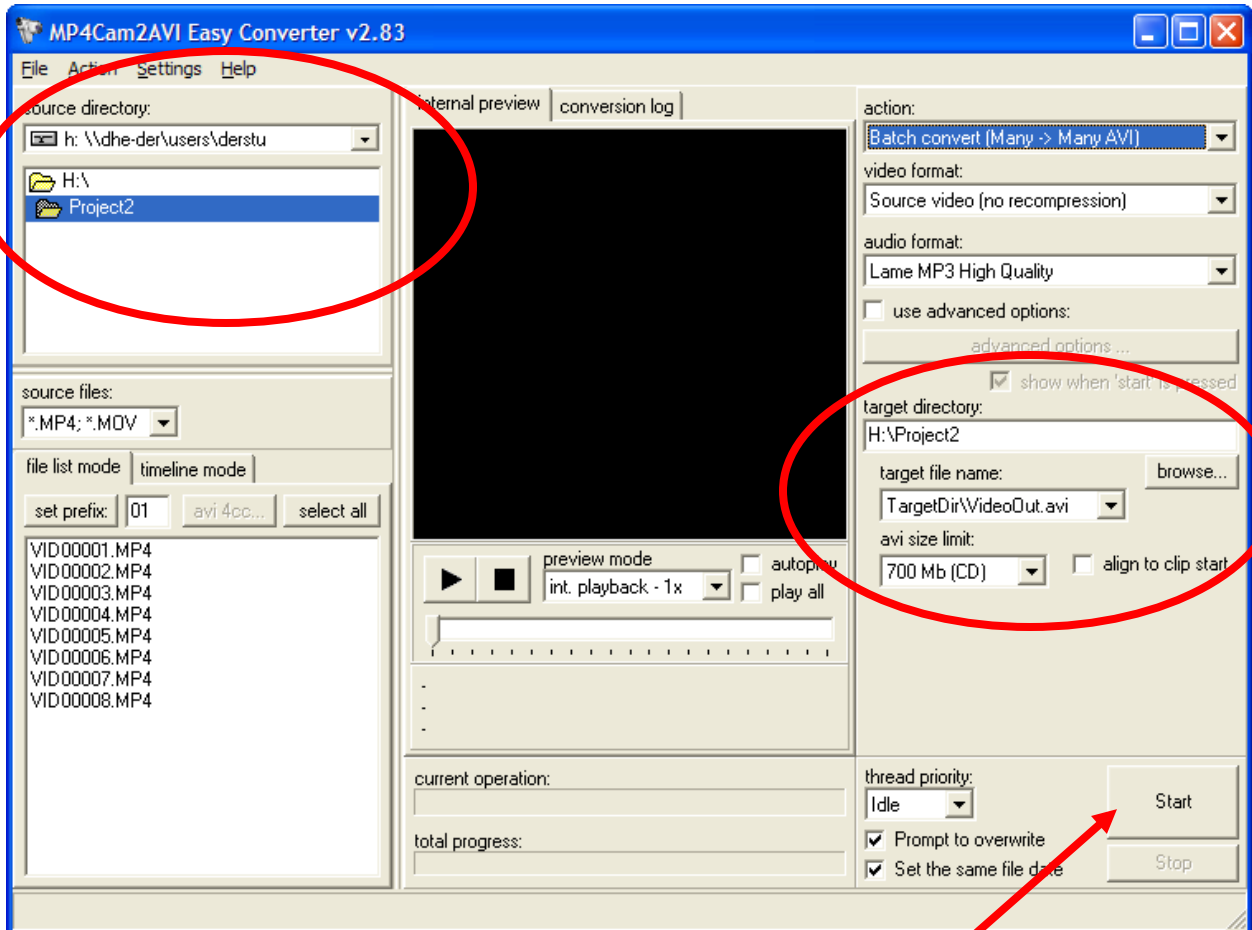
Ask your building TOA or The District HelpDesk to install it on the machines where you need to convert .mp4 files.

Once installed, Click on Start, All Programs, MISC, Mp4Cam2AVI (right next to Movie Maker)

All of the options have been set for you. The only thing you need to do is tell the program the source and target (destination) directories.

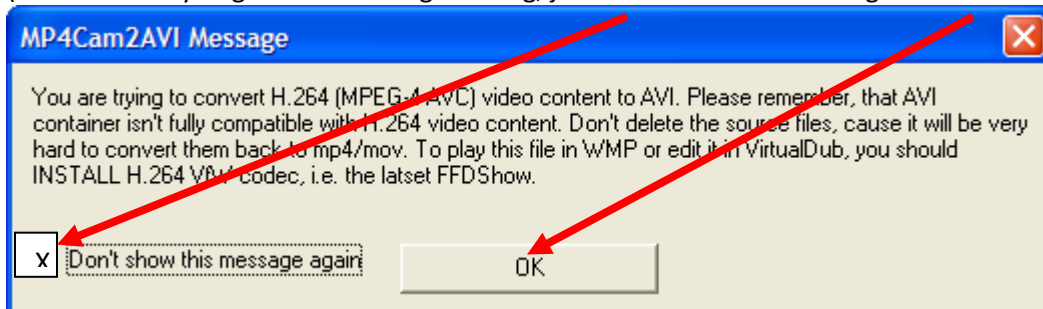
On the left side, you tell where to find your .mp4 files

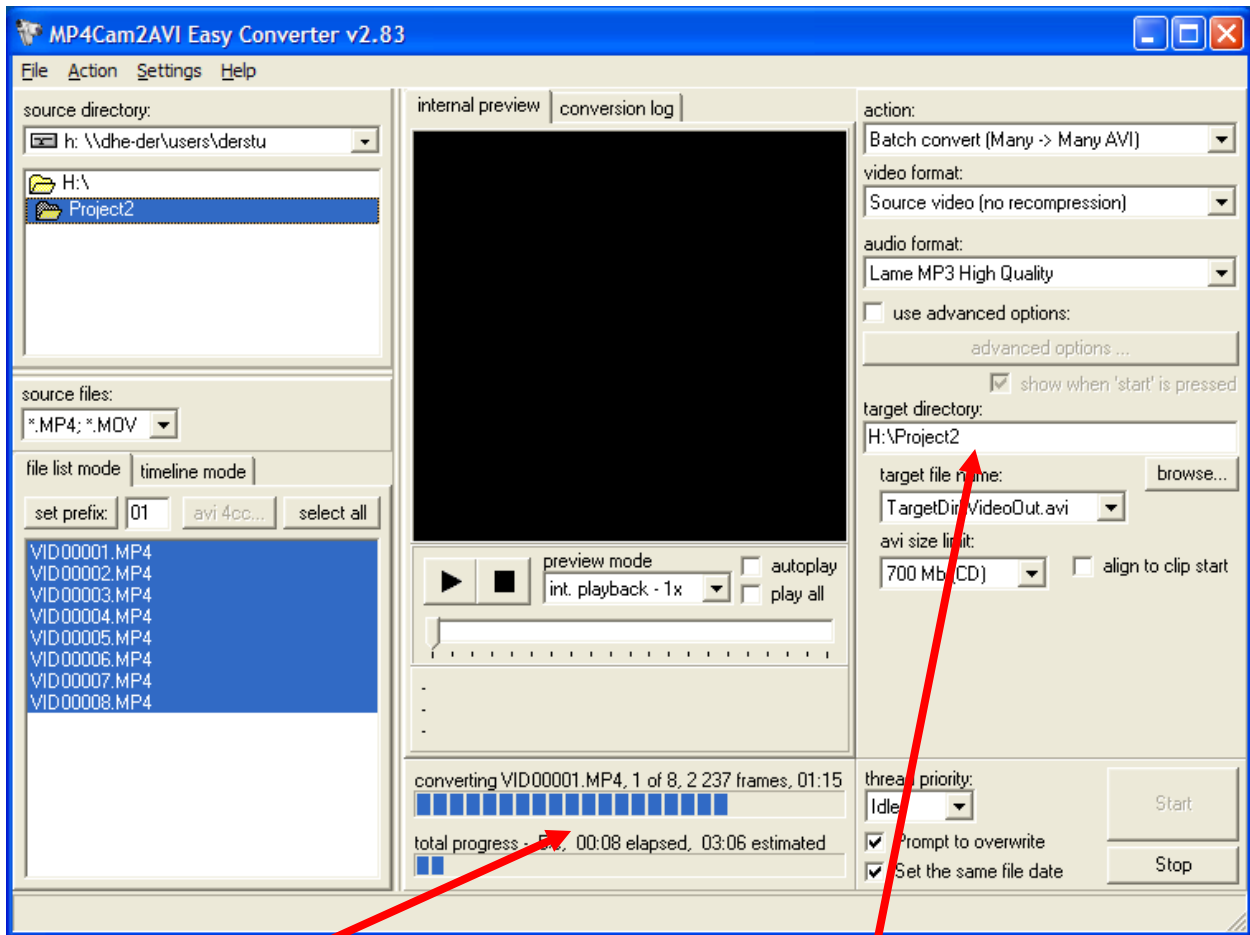
On the right you tell it where to put the converted .AVI files



Click on the Start Button.

(Note – When you get the following warning, just click on “Don’t show again” and click OK)





Progress bars are shown as it converts the .mp4 files to .avi files

And the .avi file(s) are put in the folder you specified here.

And that's all there is to it.
